Key Vocabulary

Modern history—the history of the world beginning after the Middle Ages to present day.

20th century—a period of 100 years from 1901 to 2000 . The first hundred years were the first century, starting from year 1-100, the second century from 101-200 and so on...

Leisure— the time when people are not working or occupied; free time.

Entertainment—shows, films, television or other performances or activities that are used to entertain people.

Skills:

Begin to have historical perspective (understanding the social, cultural, intellectual, and emotional settings that shaped people's lives and actions in the past)

Make use of appropriate historical terms in discussion and debate.

Independently place key events from a period onto a timeline, using sources to check for accuracy

Remember key dates and facts from a period studied and apply this knowledge in a different context (i.e discussion, debate, drama etc)

Knowledge:

In **1900**, Frank Hornby invented Meccano.

In **1911**, London had 94 registered cinemas, making up 55,000 seats.

In **1933**, half the households in Britain had a radio.

In **1937**, the largest football crowd ever recorded saw Scotland play England 149,415 people attended.

Many British families bought their first television set in order to watch the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II in 1953.

Between **1955 and 1957**, there was only one television channel.

In the late **1950s**, the first British motorways were built.

The England football team beat West Germany 4-2 on 30th July **1966**.
