In the meantime, please continue to speak with your child's class teacher as your first point of contact for any questions about your child's SEND needs or support; they know your child best and are well-placed to help.

Morning Messages/ Gate

As you will be aware, a member of our Senior Leadership Team supervises the gate each day. We kindly ask that any messages regarding individual children are passed to the adult **at your child's cloakroom door**,

"Life in all its fullness"

rather than to the staff member on the gate. On busy mornings, a number of messages can build up, and sharing them at the cloakroom door helps ensure they are received promptly and accurately. Alternatively, you are always welcome to email the school office if you prefer.

Lunchboxes

Please note that sweets are not to be brought to school in lunchboxes.

If sweets are brought into school, children will be asked to put them in their bag to take home and have at the end of the day. This helps us promote healthy eating habits and ensures all children have nutritious food during lunchtime.

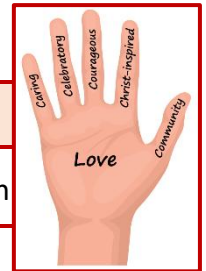
