New Communication Policy

Attached to this newsletter is our new Communication Policy, which will come into effect from September. We are really pleased to be introducing this, and in particular excited that from September parents will have access to teachers' direct email addresses as part of a clearer and more consistent communication process.

As with any communication system, there are a few important expectations around its use. These include allowing teachers up to 48 hours to respond and understanding that staff will not be responding to messages in the evenings or at weekends. Our aim is to improve communication with families while also protecting staff wellbeing and ensuring they can focus on teaching and supporting the children during the school day.
